Speaker:	<p>Ms. Nattasha Freeman CFIOSH RMaPS LLB (Hons) CIWEM, President, IOSH Nattasha Freeman is the current IOSH President and immediate past chairman of the IOSH Midland Branch, England. She has also served three years as vice-chair and three years as chair, and is also a member of the IOSH Council.</p> <p>Nattasha has been working in health, safety and environmental management for 15 years, in areas including the railway, construction and commercial sectors. Her roles have included health and safety manager for the EPS (European Passenger Service – better known as Channel Tunnel), Beyond London Project and Railtrack Major Projects, planning supervision on many retail and entertainment projects and safety management at Chase Norton Construction and pcm (part of the Pettifer Company portfolio).</p> <p>Originally Nattasha studied law but after obtaining her Law Society finals, decided that the way to ‘change the world and make a difference’ lay in safety rather than legal redress. An active safety person both professionally and outside work, Nattasha was a founding member of the WWT (Working Well Together) Midlands Action Group, which has been working with the HSE and others for the past five years to provide information and support to local small and medium-sized construction companies. Nattasha is currently director for health and safety at Phoenix Beard Property Consultants in Birmingham.</p>
