Introduction

Scientific innovation and technological advancement bring prosperity and comfort to lives. Yet technology alone does not guarantee a safer world. With a changing socio-economic landscape, global climate and increasing occurrence of natural disaster, the people in the world are increasingly vulnerable to natural disasters like typhoons, earthquakes and tsunamis, leading to nuclear and radioactive incidents, such as the recent crisis in Japan. A wide spectrum of new challenges, together with the ongoing threat of terrorist attack and outbreaks of new infectious diseases, highlight the need for a comprehensive life-saving strategy along with well-defined monitoring systems, emergency procedures, contingency plans and coordinated engineering practices.

Effective emergency management involves interactions among different parties, such as emergency services, the private sector and volunteer organisations. It is crucial that all stakeholders are adequately trained and prepared to play their roles in a coordinated manner.



Conference Theme

"New Horizons for a Safer Society" is the main theme of "Fire Asia 2012", covering the areas of performance-based solutions, engineering for safety, emergency preparedness and management of emergency services.
